

Grade 12 Math 2019-2020 Honors Agreement

The Honors program at High Tech High North County exists for students who desire an additional challenge. Students who wish to take the class for honors credit are committed to the regular class workload, plus the additional work related to the four dimensions noted in the Honors Contract.

We recognize that one reason that students take honors courses is the weighted GPA that comes with this course, which helps during college admissions. Therefore, we allow students to take courses for honors credit for which UC will grant weighted GPA's, namely junior and senior core classes.

It will be the student's responsibility to undertake the Honors work and to seek assistance from the teacher whenever necessary; specifically, Honors students are expected to use Office Hours if they are having difficulty completing the required challenge options. Honors work is graded.

Students are *expected to commit* to the Honors program for the full year and *must commit* to the Honors program for the **entire semester**. Requests to take the Honors Credit Option must be submitted to Andrew Vernon **no later than September 7th** and the request must include this signed agreement (requests will be made via Pathwright).
